For the most unique and exciting Titanic experience in Belfast, visit the only intact piece of the great ship's legacy at the Pump-House Café & Visitor Centre.

Located inside the 100 year old Edwardian Pump-House, the Visitor Centre includes a full audio-visual experience, unlocking the history of Belfast shipbuilding from the 1600s through to the launch of the Titanic.

On display inside the Pump-House will be a range of original paintings and prints for purchase by leading Irish Artists such as Simon Meyler, Gavin Fitzsimons, Terry Bradley and Eoin O'Connor.

You can also take a walk along the Dry-Dock, purchase souvenirs or simply sit back and relax in the Café with a hot snack, sandwich or cup of coffee to make your visit to Titanic's Dock and Pump-House a truly memorable experience!

Titanic's Dock & Pump-House is situated just one mile from the Odyssey on Queen's Road, Queen's Island, Belfast. We are a 15 minute walk from the Odyssey Arena. If the weather is fine, take a walk, picking up other Titanic places of interest along the way!
